

2. Answer your exam in Microsoft Word not page or anything weird. I can't open pages documents and if I can't open an exam, it doesn't get printed and sent to the professor for grading.
3. Include your exam number on every page of your uploaded exam.
4. Include the word count on the exam if requested by your professor.
5. Exam number and word counts cannot be added after your final exam submission, nor will we add them for you.
6. The system will accept repeated exam submissions until the deadline. Only the last submission uploaded before the deadline will be given to the professor.

You can submit as many separate files as required. If you wish to replace a file, first remove it from the files list.


Your essay answers will need to be saved in an approved processor program and uploaded. Click browse to locate your file and submit exam.


If you have issues signing in you may need to clear the cookies/ cache from your internet browser or try using a different browser.

Safari:




Microsoft Edge:
